Receive the host and then dip the host (*gluten free wafers are available for the asking*) into either the red wine or the white grape juice and eat, or place the host in your mouth then pick up a cup of either the red wine or the white grape juice and drink. Deposit your empty cup in the basket at the end of the line. All children are invited to come forward for a blessing if they do not normally receive communion. Return to your seat (or pause at the altar) for a time of prayer. If you are unable to come to the altar and would like communion in your pew, please let an usher or a pastor know.

From William Martin of "Feed the Harbor"

Please thank your congregation for shopping at the Feed The Harbor event. The Feed The Harbor event on February 25th provided donations of 21,720 pounds of food to 21 LOCAL food pantries. I spoke to one pantry leader whose pantry each month provides food for 347 families, representing over 1400 people in need.

The fourteenth annual "Feed The Harbor" food drive was organized by a committee representing five Churches. We estimate congregations from 22 Churches were encouraged to shop and 1000's of citizen shoppers unaware of the event in advance were given shopping lists and also donated food purchases. Approximately 150 volunteers from the Churches and the Boy Scouts participated. Publix stores were very supportive in assisting with this event. H.E.L.P. organized the pantries which also helped make this ecumenical event very successful.

Many people will be helped because others were willing to share with the less fortunate.
