

### **New Chancel Banners New Altar and Pulpit Paraments**

The banners on either side of the Chancel were designed and fabricated by Don Beck, a member of the congregation. Both banners are visual quotes from the **Book of Revelation**. The banner on the left is a depiction of **Revelation 22:2**, which describes a river of the water of life flowing through the city. On either side of the river is a tree of life, its leaves are for the healing of nations. The banner on the right continues the tree theme and adds **Revelation 4:3**, where a rainbow serves as a reminder of God's faithfulness and mercy, offering hope an comfort during times of tribulations and judgement.

The green Altar and Pulpit paraments depict the saying of Jesus in **John 5:5** "I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain I me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing."
