





#### **Council Highlights from August 2025**

MOTIONS: 1. To accept the minutes from June 2025 was carried. 2. A motion to spend up to \$500 for two shelves for Food Pantry storage, was carried. 4. A motion to spend up to \$3800 for AC to cover 4 room, was carried.

**OLD BUSINESS**: Pew adjustments have been completed to make room for movement of the piano. Food Pantry: Has serviced 191 families this month (1500-1700 individuals) with 24 new families. Additional storage is needed. Council requested a cutback in food orders so less storage required.

**FI NANCE:** A \$60,000 CD is maturing in September with \$3300 accumulated interest earned. Fidelity will reinvest the \$60,000 in a 12 mo. non-callable CD at the best rate.

A \$58,000 CD will also mature in later September. Information will be presented at the next meeting. Our church mortgage, from the original \$2.3M+, is now approximately \$113,000, due to the additional payments that have been made throughout the life of the mortgage.

Through July our donations are \$5225 below our spending, which includes the Fellowship balance of \$4014. This is \$25,810 below last year.

Through July, envelope offerings are \$20,273.54 below last year, plate offerings are up \$3656.47 and mortgage offerings are even. Total income is down \$17,406 compared to last year, which is a 5% decrease.

Through July, our expenses are \$13,451.41 below our 2025 spending plan but above last year by \$9591.62, which is a 2.9% increase.

**PROPERTY:** AC is not working in the Food Pantry where new shelves are needed. Toilets have been fixed at no cost due to lifetime warranty. Items for future discussion: cover for courtyard; quote for courtyard drainage issues.

MUTUAL MINISTRY: No meeting.


