WELCOME TO WORSHIP! We are glad YOU are here!

Are You a Visitor or Guest? We welcome you in the name of our risen Savior and we rejoice that you are here today to praise God with us. Please complete a **CONNECTION CARD** in your pew. Either place it in the offering plate or give it to one of our pastors so we can serve you better.

Holy Communion—We believe that Christ is present in this meal freely given to all who are baptized. Please approach the altar as directed. Receive the host and then dip the host (*gluten free wafers are available for the asking*) into either the red wine or the white grape juice and eat, or place the host in your mouth then pick up a cup of either the red wine or the white grape juice and drink. Deposit your empty cup in the basket at the end of the line. All children are invited to come forward for a blessing if they do not normally receive communion. Return to your seat (or pause at the altar) for a time of prayer. If you are unable to come to the altar and would like communion in your pew, please let an usher or a pastor know.

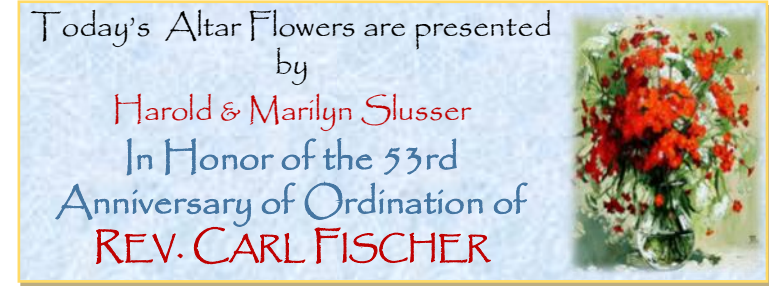

Born June 15, 1923 in Flint, Michigan, June’s 1st job was working in the claims department of an insurance and realty company. She was promoted over the years until she was vice president. Not content with this job, she applied to the Navy Department in Washington, D.C. when they advertised open positions. The director of the Naval Personnel budget chose her to help with preparing budget books for submission to Congress. Later she applied for a position as assistant to the Comptroller of the Peace Corps. Their office was across from the White House where she was a frequent visitor to view the interior during holidays and special occasions. Complications from eye surgery necessitated an early medical retirement. In 1979 she moved to Port Charlotte to be with her sister, Ruth. During her retirement years here she devoted full time to her genealogy research, helping people with Swedish - Finnish ancestry. She commented that the Swedish Finn Historical Society in Seattle, WA (SFHS) considers her as possibly the oldest practicing genealogist in the country; she is also well-known among genealogists in Finland.
